Faculty of Computer and Information Science

Courses (Predmeti)

- Courses for exchange students are listed on the web
 - some courses are in English, some in Slovene
- Your Learning Agreement (LA) determines your courses
 - change of courses in LA has to be approved by Coordinator at FRI and your home institution
 - consult the tutors if you have questions
- Schedule is published on the web https://urnik.fri.uni-lj.si
 - but course names in Slovenian (search by code)
 - school hour lasts 45 minutes, starts 15 minutes past full hour
- All courses have
 - lectures (P) and
 - (one cycle) tutorials/laboratory sessions (AV/LV)

Grading System

- UL uses marks 5 to 10
 - 6 to 10: pass
 - 5: fail

Description

- 10 = Excellent (91% 100% correct)
- 9 = Very good (81% 90% correct)
- 8 = Good (71% 80% correct)
- 7 = Satisfactory (61% 70% correct)
- 6 = Sufficient (51% 60% correct)



Formalities

- Enrolment Number (Student ID Number)
 - get at UL (70xxxxxx) or FRI (63xxxxxx)
- Citizen Number (EMŠO)
 - get at FRI (e.g. 0104980500123)
- Student Card receive later in October
 - get at UL or FRI
 - return at the end of exchange
 - when annulled you can get it back as a souvenir
 - if lost, revoke and ask for duplicate!
- Digital ID UL (e.g. ab1234@student.uni-lj.si)
 - activate at id.uni-lj.si
 - study IS Studis, online classroom, wireless network EduRoam, computer rooms...

Residence permit for EU residents

Documentation:

- Signed application form
- Photo
- Enrolment confirmation
- Health insurance (Blue EU card copy)
- Statement of student about sufficient finance for living in Slovenia (421,89€/month)
- Statement of intended stay
- Certified copy of a valid identitiy document
- fee 21,92€

Residence permit for non EU residents

Documentation:

- Signed application form
- Colour Photo
- Enrolment confirmation certificate
- Health insurance
- Sufficient finance for living in Slovenia (421,89€/month)
 - Documentation for scholarship
 - Bank statement about financial means on your account or your parents: 402,18*12 months of study
- A police clearance certificate not older than 3 months with apostile (depends on country) and translation in Slovene
- A certified copy of a valid passport
 - It has to be valid 3 months longer then the intended stay in Slovenia
 - Copy of the page with the date of your arrival to Slovenia, or copy of visa
- Submits fingerprints at the Administrative Unit
- Confirmation of the fee payment: 54,50€ + 15,47€

 - personal Urbana time card, monthly student ticket (unlimited travel)
 - Apply with a paper form
- Bicikelj (bike rental)
 - 3€ per year
- Subsidized meals (<u>link</u>)
 - Where: Student Campus at Pivovarniška 6
 - Procedure: registration online, approval at premises
 - EMŠO number
 - Acceptance letter
 - Boni app (european mobile number)
- Student Organization of University of Ljubljana (ŠOU v Ljubljani)

 - meal coupons, ESN cards, events, Welcome week



Study

 - for some you will have individual assignments




- FRI online classroom (Moodle)

Studis

- electronic index
- exam dates, registration for exams, exam results, final grades
- ordering Transcript of Records
- https://studij.fri.uni-lj.si/
- available in English
- change the language
- login with your Digital ID UL
- 49 logins without a certificate



Exams

- Exam dates published
 - in online classroom, in Studis
 - 3 dates available for each course
 - only 2 exam dates in the spring exam period
 - if you fail, you can retake the exam
- You should register for each exam
 - if only oral exam agreed with the professor, register for the first written exam date
 - register in Studis at least two days before the exam
 - exam results (scores) are published in Studis
 - students usually informed by email
 - check your @student.uni-lj.si email!
 - when you pass the exam, your final grade is recorded in Studis

Transcript of Records

- At the end of your stay you need to get your Transcript of Records (ToR)
 - when all your grades are in Studis
 - collect ToR at the International Office at FRI (room R3.73) or online
 - during office hours
 - or outside office hours on previous arrangement by email
- or if you have already returned home
 - ToR can be sent to your home address

IMPORTANT: If you want to retake any exam in the fall examination period, please, inform the International Office before your departure!
